PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT

The Ministry of Land Reform, Oshikoto Region, has been inundated with reports of illegal land allocations and selling of plots at Oerwoud farm No. 1150 and Tsintsabis Farm No. 881 respectively in Oshikoto region. The two (2) farms belong to the Ministry of Land Reform and were purchased for the purpose of resettlement in accordance with Section 14 of the Agricultural (Commercial) Land Reform Act, Act No. 5 of 1995 (ACLRA). Additionally, Section 37 of the ACLRA gives power to the Minister of Land Reform to allocate land in resettlement farms.

The Ministry of Land Reform is informing members of the public to refrain from illegally acquiring and illegally buying land in these farms. Those allegedly selling and allocating land in the two (2) farms have no power to do so. Furthermore, the public is hereby informed that investigation of illegal activities reported is ongoing and legal actions will be taken against those found to be contravening the ACLRA.
